MIDWEST

Illinois - The Wadsworth Company is currently working on two separate remodeling projects. Evanston GC, in Skokie, is undergoing an eighteen-hole restoration with Ron Pritchard as the designer. Arthur Hills/Steve Forrest & Associates is the designer of a major, eighteen-hole renovation project at Naperville CC.

Missouri - In Chesterfield, construction is progressing at Forest Hills CC, a remodeling project under the direction of Art Schaupter.

Texas - Frisco Lakes is a new, eighteen-hole, Gary Stephenson designed golf course just completed in Frisco. The Wadsworth Company is also working with Gary Stephenson at Sun City GC in Georgetown, a new, eighteen-hole project with Pulte Homes as the Owner.

In Port Aransas, The Newport GC is an Arnold Palmer designed, new, eighteen-hole golf course being constructed for G & H Development, Ltd. KemperSports is set to manage the facility upon completion.

Delaware - The City of Wilmington has hired the Wadsworth Company to completely reconstruct Rock Manor. Designed by Lester George, the reconfigured eighteen holes will incorporate some of the previous hole corridors and have a new look and feel upon completion.

Virginia - Harbor Station, a new-eighteen hole golf course in Dumfries, is presently under construction. This Jack Nicklaus / Rick Jacobson design collaboration is being constructed for Lee Carolina LLC.

Down the road in Hampton, construction is progressing at Langley AFB on a thirty-six hole remodeling project designed by Lester George and for Exelon Services Federal Group.

SOUTHEAST

Florida - The Aerie Course at The Club at Twin Eagles has recently been completed by the Wadsworth Company. This new, nine-hole golf course, located in Naples and designed by Gary Player, was constructed for The Bonita Bay Group. In Pace, The Jubilee Golf Club is a new, eighteen-hole golf course project currently under construction. The Eagle Group is the Owner; Jerry Pate is the golf course designer.

North Carolina - Bob Moore of JMP Golf Design is the golf course designer at North River, a new, eighteen-hole project in Beaufort being built for Guide Group LLC.

South Carolina - Construction is moving ahead on Phase I work at Hollow Creek, a new, eighteen-hole golf course designed by Clyde Johnston. Woodside Golf LLC is the Owner.

SOUTHWEST

California - The Wadsworth Company is busy constructing numerous golf courses throughout the state. In Truckee, a new, eighteen-hole, John Harbottle / Johnny Miller design called Timilick is currently being constructed for Martis Valley Associates. And just down the road, Martis Camp is a new, eighteen-hole, Tom Fazio designed golf course being built for DMB / Highlands Group. A new, eighteen-hole putting course, designed by Dick Bailey, shall serve as an additional amenity for this development.

Cache Creek is a new, eighteen-hole golf course being constructed by the Wadsworth Company in Brooks. Designed by Brad Bell, the golf course will become an integral part of the Cache Creek Casino Resort, owned by the Rumsey Band of Wintun Indians.

John Fought is the golf course designer at Ridge Creek, a new, eighteen-hole golf course being constructed for the city of Dinuba. The golf course, managed by KemperSports, will feature a nearly 360-degree practice facility, with multiple chipping and target greens.

In southern California, the Wadsworth Company is nearing completion of The Crossings at Carlsbad, a new, eighteen-hole, golf course being constructed for the city of Carlsbad. Managed by KemperSports, the Greg Nash design extends over vast, rolling terrain with distant views of the Pacific Ocean.

In Indian Wells, the Players Course at Indian Wells Golf Resort is currently under construction. Owned by the city of Indian Wells, and managed by OB Sports, the John Fought designed, eighteen-hole remodeling project will have a more traditional look and feel than its sister course, the Celebrity Course, designed by Clive Clark. Recently completed by the Wadsworth Company in the summer of 2006, the Celebrity Course features expansive landscape areas, numerous lakes and streams, and large, transplanted, mature trees. The Celebrity Course has also recently been chosen as the future site of the annual, Thanksgiving weekend, LG Skins Game.

The Links at Summerly, located in Lake Elsinore and designed by Cal Olson, is an eighteen-hole, links-style golf course being constructed as part of a new, residential development by John Laing Homes.




Idaho - In Kootenai County, just south of Coeur d'Alene, the Wadsworth Company is commencing with the construction of Black Rock North, a new, eighteen-hole project designed by Tom Weiskopf.



Tetherow - Bend, OR

Oregon - Tetherow, located in Bend, is a new, eighteen-hole project designed by David McLay Kidd. Constructed for Arrowood Development, and managed by OB Sports, this golf course is situated next door to The Broken Top Club, also constructed by the Wadsworth Company in the early 1990's.
